Cancellation & Refund Policy, Payments, Travel Insurance, Transfers, Weather Credits

Travel Insurance: SWS Mountain Guides strongly recommends that all participants purchase travel insurance to protect themselves from unforeseen circumstances. In addition, travel insurance can protect your investment in a trip if you must cancel at the last minute. SWS Mountain Guides recommends **Global Rescue & Travel Insurance** for your adventure travel & rescue insurance choice; they have many options & work with you to get you the best coverage.

Domestic Courses, including Custom & Private Guiding:

A non-refundable 50% deposit is required with each reservation, and the BALANCE is due 30 days prior the course starting date. If you pay your course fee in total and cancel your reservation more than 30 days prior to the course start date, your course fee balance is refundable, less your non-refundable deposit. We are sorry, but NO REFUNDS or credits are made within 30 days of the course starting date. Travel Insurance Highly Recommended: <u>Global Rescue & Travel Insurance</u>

International Expeditions & Treks: A 25% deposit is required to book International Expeditions or Treks; an additional 25% deposit is required 90 days prior to departure, with the balance due 60 days prior to departure. If you cancel your reservation 90 days or more prior to your expedition or trek, a \$1,000.00 cancellation fee is required, and your expedition or trek fee balance is refundable. A 50% cancellation fee is required with the balance being refundable when cancellations are received between 60-90 days prior to the course departure. We are sorry, but NO REFUNDS or credits are made within 60 days prior to the course starting date. **Travel Insurance Highly Recommended: Global Rescue & Travel Insurance**

Transfer Fees:

You may move your domestic course reservation to another scheduled course when we receive a \$100.00 nonrefundable transfer fee. All transfer requests must be received more than 30 days before your domestic course start date. Sorry, no transfers are made within 30 days of your domestic course start date. Note: Policy does not apply to International Treks and Expeditions.

Canceled Courses:

Sierra Wilderness Seminars Inc., dba SWS Mountain Guides, California Ski Guides and California Rock Guides reserves the right to cancel and/or reschedule climbs or courses due to minimum bookings or other unforeseen circumstances. You may receive a refund or credit when the course is canceled, rescheduled, or transferred to another course. SWS Mountain Guides, aka Sierra Wilderness Seminars Inc., is not responsible for additional expenses, including non-refundable airline tickets, equipment, medical expenses, etc. We recommend you obtain trip cancellation insurance to protect yourself. Weather Credits and Rescheduled Climbs & Courses:

Sierra Wilderness Seminars Inc. reserves the right to reschedule seminars and courses due to severe weather conditions or other uncontrollable circumstances which make the course or climb unsafe to continue. Weather Credit or Partial Weather Credit may be given for courses or climbs during or within 24 hrs. of the course start dates if severe weather conditions or other uncontrollable circumstances make the course or climb unsafe to continue. Our decision will be at the discretion of the climb leader and the Director(s) of SWS Mountain Guides.

Note: Weather credit is an SWS Mountain Guides, California Ski Guides, or California Rock Guides Gift Certificate. Which can be redeemed for any courses, climbs, or clinics offered by SWS Mountain Guides, California Ski Guides, or California Rock Guides. These credits are encouraged to be used within one year.
